



Create a calm and inviting entrance hall with Bolia

Regardless of where it is placed, the entrance hall is where first impressions are made. From the moment you cross the doorstep, according to Bolia, the space is meant to calmly welcome the visitor inside and give them a feeling of home. Bolia signs for this very particular space three novelties as well as a new, natural finishing.

It is an essential item for the entrance hall: the coat rack. Benditas Studio entered Bolia Design Awards 2020 with Cocoon, a new interpretation of this functional piece, in a natural and authentic design. Cocoon is multifunctional and features a hand-woven basket that allows the frame to rest firmly on the ground, while providing additional storage space for gloves, umbrellas and small accessories. From this frame rise three smooth, rounded legs, made of soap-treated oak, connected at the top by a fourth wooden piece, allowing elegant and easy storage for jackets, coats and hats.



To add depth to this often narrow space and to check one's appearance before going out in public, the mirror is one of those other entrance hall essentials. Büro Famos has created a new model in black or beige lacquered metal, Ripple, available in two timeless versions. Their architectural look is inspired by the arched windows of the Romanesque period, to which they add a modern and elegant touch. Ripple is available in a slim, rounded top or rectangular version to fit any space.



The Ukrainian designer Pavel Vetrov presents his new interpretation of the shelf, in a model that will find its place particularly in the entrance halls thanks to its moderate size and its simple but crafted silhouette. Wave is three-dimensional and pays homage to its name through the relief of the wood on its third, which adds a delicate subtlety to the overall shape. It reflects the designer's refined approach and taste for tactile and authentic materials - Waves is simply made of oiled white oak.



The latest piece edited by Bolia for the entrance hall, the Posea bench by Granstudio. This is not really a novelty: this elegant series of benches and storage furniture with a characteristic design language already existed. However, this fall a new finish was added to the series in the form of a new sheepskin option, Vella. This one brings more softness to the original finishes and plays with the distinctive metal frame that is the DNA of Posea. It will be ideal in an entrance hall to tie your shoes or simply to add warmth to the space.
